Official Transcript Requests



A new function has been added to MaineStreet for students: current and recently active students may now request an official transcript using their Student Center. The electronic transcript request was made available in September and allows students to request a transcript from UMaine as well as the other University of Maine System institutions, without requiring a signed release. Applying for Graduation

Students who wish to apply for graduation may now do so using their Student Center in MaineStreet. This new function not only allows the student to initiate the application, but updates are permitted for an application that was previously submitted. Students have the ability to update their application data including the name displayed on the diploma and the address to which the diploma will be sent. Academic Summary

An Academic Summary is now available in the Student Center under the Academic History section which displays current program, plan and sub-plan information, current academic standing, current accumulative GPA and Earned Hours and any degrees previously awarded.

What's new on MaineStreet for Faculty/Advisors?



Many improvements to the Faculty Center in MaineStreet have recently been completed.

- An Academic Information link has been added to the Student Details drop-down menu which displays the academic career(s), program(s), plan(s), academic class level, and enrollment PIN.
- A link has been added to the Student Details drop-down menu for the Quick Enroll component.
- The links for "Proposed Schedule" and "Approve Schedule" in the Student Details drop-down menu have been changed to "Wish List" and "Approve Wish List," respectively.
- The Wish List has been changed so that all courses display, instead of showing, for example, the first four of six.
- The Class Search has been modified to display the Additional Search Criteria area by default, as well as the category for the General Education class search.
- The instructor's weekly schedule has been changed to show the schedule for the current week, and final exams have been added to the weekly schedule.
- The instructor name and class meeting times have been added to the Grade Roster header.

FERPA Tip:



Do we sell students' directory information?

Yes. The University is required by law to provide directory information to third parties including businesses and military liaisons. The law allows for collection of payment for this information, half of which is given to the UMaine Student Government. Any student who has requested suppression from directory information based on FERPA, is excluded from any information provided to third parties.
