Student's Weekly Schedule

The Weekly Schedule available for viewing in the Student Services Center is a useful tool by providing a clear view of the class meetings for a given week. But, what if a class for which a student is enrolled has no actual class meetings such as an online class?



The class information for these classes does display on the Weekly Schedule, but they're at the bottom of the page under the heading of 'Meeting Information not available." And, if a

student is on a wait list for the class, the "Waiting" message will display beside the course.

A recent addition to the Weekly Schedule: A box displays below the schedule grid showing class notes for any of the classes for which the student is enrolled. This includes the URL links for online classes.





The My Class Schedule link, also available in the Student Services Center, displays the class schedule information in list form and now also includes the class note information as well as

the "Waiting" status for the classes for which the student is wait listed.

Searching for Academic Year Calendar

he Office of Student Records makes every effort to insure that our website has up-to-date information available. This involves routinely removing outdated links and



documents so accurate information is provided. However, some departments opt to add these documents to their own websites, but may not have the most up-todate version. As a result, a web search may result in the selection of an outdated document. Over the last several months, this type of situation has caused confusion regarding the Academic Year Calendar. The best way to be sure you're finding an accurate calendar is to go the OSR website rather than performing a browser search. If you opt to browse for the document, note the date on the document and verify that it is the latest version.

The OSR website has access to the most recent calendars on the <u>Academics</u> tab. Links for the past and current Academic Year Calendars bring the user to the associated *Undergraduate Catalog*, and a link to a PDF is available for the future Academic Year Calendar.

Communication to Students

The University of Maine System has designated MaineStreet email as the email account of record for all students, including those at UMaine. All official correspondence between the university and its students will be addressed to the student's MaineStreet email account (e.g. bananas@maine.edu). Critical information regarding student email, including mail forwarding recommendations, is found at <u>http://umaine.edu/portal/</u> <u>communication/</u>.



MaineStreet offers the option for instructors and advisors to communicate with their students from within the class roster, grade roster and Advisor Center by using the "notify" button available on these pages. When this process is

used, the communication is automatically sent to the student's MaineStreet email account.
